ORDER

The time limit for crediting arrears of Dearness Allowance to the Provident Fund Account of the employees sanctioned as per Government Orders read from 1st to 18th paper above were extended vide G.O. read as 19th paper above and the time limit extended therein expired on 31st October 2015. The time limit for crediting the arrears of DA to the Provident Fund account of employees sanctioned as per Government Order read as 20th paper above expired in February 2016. The arrears of DA sanctioned as per Government Order read as 21st paper above can be drawn and credited to the Provident Fund account of the employee along with the salary bill up to June 2016.

Several requests are being received from various Heads of Institutions and individuals seeking extension of time for crediting the arrears of DA to the Provident Fund Account for the period from 01.01.2005 onwards.

Government have examined the requests in detail and are pleased to order that the time limit for crediting the arrears of DA sanctioned from 01.01.2005 to 01.07.2015 to the Provident Fund Account of employees as per the respective orders read above will be extended up to 31st October 2016. The Dearness Allowance arrears can be claimed in the salary bill up to 31st October 2016 and credited to Provident Fund Account without fail.

All controlling officers will adhere to the time schedule invariably.
